Rising third graders are required to read one book. Students will receive a <u>100 TEST GRADE</u> in reading for completing this **REQUIRED** assignment. Students who read more than one book will be rewarded from the Chick-fil-A Summer Reading Program.

- **Parents and students may choose chapter books based on interest of the student. All books must have at least 60 pages.
- **Documentation of the summer reading is to be turned in to the student's teacher by Friday of the first full week of school. Children completing this assignment will also receive their individual earned prize or prizes (coupons from Chick-fil-A).

3RD GRADE MATH REQUIREMENTS

Dear Parents,

We would like to first wish you a happy and fun filled summer. We hope that you will find time to draw closer to the Lord, and to each other. We too, are excited about a break in which to rest and reflect. Time seems to pass so quickly over the summer break and before you know it, we will be back in school, ready for a brand new school year.

I would like to tell you a little about what we will teach in math in third grade and what you can do with your child over the summer to help ensure their success next year. The textbook we use is *Progress in Mathematics* Sadlier-Oxford. This textbook helps students to become engaged, reflective and confident problem solvers. You may take a sneak peak at our math curriculum by visiting www.sadlier-oxford.com/math.

During the summer please review addition and subtraction with your child so they may recall facts quickly. We will begin our school year with place value (ones, tens, hundreds) and move into adding and subtracting with regrouping. If they know their addition and subtraction facts they will start off the school year very confident and be successful in the first few chapters.

Second, begin working on memorizing multiplication facts 0-12. Sadlier-Oxford introduces multiplication in second grade as well as most math textbooks. We cannot express to you enough how important it is that you begin to work with your child on memorizing the multiplication table over the summer. Multiplication is the foundation of what we will build on for the majority of the year because it is directly related to division, fractions, and decimals.

The number one struggle for our students in previous years is that they are not able to recall math facts and it impairs their ability to problem solve. So if you will commit to work on these two area your child will come into third grade math very strong, confident, and successful. We hope you enjoy your summer, and we look forward to seeing you in the fall!
